1. Boehnke, Hans W. Lectured on a treatment approach for foot turn in, in children. Presented at the Ontario Chiropractic Association Convention 1977
2. Boehnke, Hans W. Assisted in teaching a basic 50 hour course on Applied Kinesiology in Toledo, Ohio, along with Dr. Lance West, D.C. DIBAK, and Dr. David Engel D.C. DIBAK; The course dates were October 13, November 10, December 8, 1990; January 19, March 16, 1991.

The techniques and presenters were Applied Kinesiology by Dr. Hans Boehnke D.C. DIBAK, Diversified technique by Dr. Adrian Grice, D.C. MSc., FCCS and Gonstead technique by Dr. Greg Plaucher, D.C. This seminar took place on April 24-25, 1993.
5. Boehnke, Hans W. Presented an introductory 1.5 hour lecture on Applied Kinesiology at The Institut fur Sportmedizin und Pravention at the University of Potsdam, in Potsdam Germany. This took place on June 6, 1993.
6. Boehnke, Hans W. gave a lecture and practical demonstration of treatment of patients of Dr Smitka (a German Orthopedic Specialist), in front of a Medical audience at The Institute fur Sportmedizin und Pravention at the University of Potsdam in Potsdam Germany. Dr. Smitka (an Orthopedic Specialist), had selected some problem patients, introduced them to the audience and explained the treatments given, and the difficulty in getting improvement with them. He then turned them over to Dr. Boehnke to analyze, diagnose, treat, and then reanalyze in front of the group. There were 6 possibly 7 patients. The presentation took over 3 hours. There appeared to be a lot of improvement in some patients and some improvement in all of them. This took place on September 5, 1994.
7. Boehnke, Hans W. Taught the 50 hour course, 'The Essentials of Applied Kinesiology in Clinical Practice', in Alberta, Canada, alternating locations between Edmonton and Calgary.
